



INTRODUCTION:

Bharatiya Vidya Bhavan Shools are English Medium School based on Indian Culture. Our culture stands for **RITA, SATYA, YAGNA and TAPAS.** Our forefathers lived and died for Satyam, Shivam, Sundaram - Truth, Love and beauty. These Values are embedded in our national outlook.

OBJECTIVE:

Bharatiya Vidya Bhavan, an international educational and cultural organisation started this School to provide a rich stimulating and satisfying environment to the Children for the promotion of their all round physical, mental, moral and social development.

It aims to equip the child with self confidence and help the students to value and use their freedom judiciously.

Hence, the purpose of the School is not only to impart instruction but also to help the child unfold his/her hidden potential and achieve excellence in every field of life.

Rules and Regulations: Regular attendance and study habits, prompt obedience, courtesy in speech and conduct is expected.

The permanent unaided school is recognized by the Govt. of Maharashtra and prepares its students for the secondary school certificate examination in Std. X.

I. VERY IMPORTANT:

- Corporal punishment is strictly prohibited in school.
- The school does not recommend tuitions and doesn't permit its teachers to accept private tuition.
- Students of all classes are strictly prohibited from bringing mobile phones, cameras, i-pods, tablets or any other gadgets to school. They are not permitted to come to school riding vehicles except bicycles.

II. School Uniform:

Students should be in full uniform with polished shoes and neatly ironed dress on all school days and important school functions.

Regular School Uniform:

Grey T-shirt, Black track pant, Dark navy blue colour sweat shirt.

Shoes - Black colour canvas shoes, Socks - plain white.

P.T. Uniform : (Std. I to X) House colour - Red, Blue, Yellow, Green T-shirt and Black track pant.

Shoes - Black canvas, Socks - plain white, each student must wear the P.T. uniform according to his/her respective house colour on every Friday (Std. I to VII) and every Wednesday (Std. VIII to X).

No student should come to school without uniform. If, for some valid reason, a student cannot wear his/her uniform he/she should bring a note of excuse from his/her parents/guardians.

Each student must have sufficient number of uniforms.

Hair Code: 1] Boys should have their hair close cut (NDA Cut) and neatly oiled and combed. 2] Girls should have a simple hair style. Long hair - two plaits, black hair band, black bow. Short hair - above collar only hair band, hair upto shoulders - two ponytails and black hairband, a pair of small stud earrings permitted.

III. Attendance:

- Std. I to IX students should have 75% attendance of the total working days in each term is a must for promotion to the next class.
- **Std. X** students should have 75% attendance for each term and is an important criteria during S.S.C. Board Examination form filling.
- Prior permission from the headmistress must be obtained for grant of leave for three days and more. It is important to mention the reason of absence from school.
- Half day leave will not be granted.
- Student suffering from an infection should furnish a doctor's certificate declaring fitness.
- If a child remains absent for over a month without permission or is

irregular in attendance, his / her name will be struck off the roll. However long absence may be condoned at the discretion of the Headmistress.

• It is compulsory to attend the first day of school after the holidays and the last day before the holidays.

IV. Evaluation:

 Std. I to VIII – According to the RTE act 2010 Continuous Comprehensive Evaluation - All students must achieve minimum C2 grade in Formative and Summative assessment of every subject to be promoted to the next class.

If student remains absent during the assessment, retest will not be conducted.

 Std. IX – Promotion to Std. X will depend on the student achieving 35% as the minimum level of learning overall in orals, practical and written examination.

The final average for promotion will be considered on the basis of the work completed in the academic year (unit test, assignments, completion of books, submission of science journals, projects, I Term and Final Examinations).

Maximum 20 grace marks and not more than 10% of the total marks in any subject can be given for promotion.

V. School Library:

- Library books will be issued to students from Std. V to X on a specific day of the week as mentioned by the librarian.
- Library books must not be interchanged. Every student is responsible for the book he / she borrows and must be handled with care.
- If a book is destroyed, damaged or lost, the concerned student will have to bear the cost and failure to do so will result in the concerned student paying a fine.
- It is compulsory for the students to return the book to the library before the commencement of both the term end examinations.
- Parents are requested to donate books to the library.

VI. Fees:

- Fees are to be paid in two instalments (First Term June and Second Term November)
- Admission fees once paid is non refundable.
- If fees can not be paid in time, prior written permission must be obtained from Headmistress.

- 1] The student is solely responsible for his personal belongings in school. Any damages to school property caused by the student have to be compensated by parents.

- 6] **Tiffin bearers** will not be allowed to enter the main school building during the lunch break.


7] The school will not be responsible for students who remain behind for more than 30 minutes after the school gets over.

- A student who is absent for any examination during the academic year is not eligible for the prize or scholarship.
- A student's character will also be taken into consideration to be eligible for a prize. A child should maintain a clear character sheet in the school calendar. Regular attendance, good conduct & application throughout the year are indispensable conditions for obtaining any scholarship.
- Rule 2 is not applicable to students who represent the school in sports.


